Test Room Regulations for Candidates

1. Entering for the Test

- 1.1 You are required to present the original copy of a photo ID on the day of the test. Failure to do so will result in the entry being denied without any refund of fees.
- 1. 2 The Test Administration Board will not be responsible for any personal valuables you bring to the Test Room.
- 1.3 Electronics such as mobile phones, beepers are to be turned off prior to entering the test room.
- 1.4 No items other than personal ID, the Test Book, the Answer Sheet, pencils, and erasers may be placed on the desktop. Please put them in front of the test room.
- 1.5 You should check your seat prior to entering the test room.
- 1.6 You must arrive on time for the test. If you are late by over 10 minutes, your entry will be denied.
- 1.7 You may not smoke, eat or drink once you enter the test room.

2. During the Test

- 2.1 Put your photo ID on desktop and check to ensure that the information on the seat label matches that on your Answer Sheet. Any mismatch should be reported to the Test Monitor immediately.
- 2.2 You may not leave the test room within the first 40 minutes after the test begins. Violators will have their test candidacy revoked.
- 2.3 There are no breaks during the test session. You must request and have the permission of the test monitor if you have to go to the restroom. Candidates requesting to go to the restroom must do so accompanied by a test monitor. The test time will not be extended for anyone requesting to go to the restroom.
- 2.4 You must not communicate in any way with other candidates, glance at another candidate's answer sheets, bring in notes of any kind, make disturbance, or affect other candidates' performance. Violators will be required to leave the test room immediately and the candidacy revoked.
- 2.5 If you are found involve in malpractice of any sort, you will be required to leave the test room immediately with your candidacy revoked. You may not register for the same test in 3 years.
- 2.6 If you do not follow the instructions of the Test Monitor or fail to abide by the Regulations, you will be required to leave the test room immediately with your candidacy revoked.
- 2.7 Follow the Test Monitor's instructions in case of any unexpected incidents during the test session.



3. After the Test

- 3.1 If you finish the test before the session ends and volunteer to stop the test, you should exit the test room, leave the Test Book and Answer Sheet on desktop or hand them over to the Test Monitor.
- 3.2 Do not linger, make any noise, involve in discussion in areas nearby after exiting the test room.
- 3.3 If any candidate is found to be involved in any incident that may affect the fair administration of the test, it shall be immediately reported to the Test Administration Board for decisions.

1	Candidate enters Test Room more than 10 minutes late.	Test Room Regulation #4	Entry denied. If a candidate forcefully enters, remind him/her that the candidacy is revoked and no transcript is to be issued. Take note of the candidate's name and arriving time on the Log Sheet for report to the Administration Board.	
2	Candidate leaves Test Room within first 40 minutes after test begins.	Test Room Regulation #4	Exit denied. If the candidate persists, remind him/her that the candidacy is revoked and no transcript is to be issued. Take note of the candidate's name on the Log Sheet for report to the Administration Board.	
3	Candidate lacks proper identification (citizenship/social security card, driver's license or passport).	Test Room Regulation #5	Entry denied. If a candidate forcefully enters, remind him/her that the candidacy is revoked and no transcript is to be issued. Take note of the candidate's name on the Log Sheet for report to the Administration Board.	
4	Candidate glances around, talks, attempts to look at another's test, or allows another to look at his/her test.	Test Room Regulation #6	Give a serious warning. If necessary, rearrange seating. Warn him/her that the candidacy may be revoked. Take note of the candidate's name on the Log Sheet for report to the Administration Board.	
5	Candidate passes notes, copies, uses cheat-sheets, exchanges answer cards, etc.	Test Room Regulation #6	Confiscate related evidence. Warn him/her that the candidacy may be revoked. Take note of the candidate's name on the Log Sheet for report to the Administration Board.	
6	Test-related writing found on desk, chairs, stationery, body, or carried-in articles.	Test Room Regulation #6	Confiscate and retain the articles for evidence. Whether the evidence can be retained, warn him/her that the candidacy may be revoked. Take note of the candidate's name on the Log Sheet for report to the Administration Board.	
7	Candidate smokes, makes noise, or disturbs others.	Test Room Regulation #6	Require immediate discontinuation. If the candidate persists, notify the Test Administration Board to send executives to manage the condition.	
8	After leaving the Test Room, candidate lingers and makes noise or announces answers.	Test Room Regulation #6	Require immediate discontinuation. If the candidate persists, notify the Test Administration Board to send executives to manage the condition.	



9	Candidate poses as someone else.	Test Room Regulation #6	Warn the candidate that the candidacy is revoked. Take note of the candidate's name on the Log Sheet for report to the Administration Board. The registered candidate and imposter will be banned from the test for three years.
10	Candidate takes Question Paper or Answer Sheet out of Test Room.	Test Room Regulation #8	Immediately stop the candidates and retrieve the test materials and report to the Test Administration Board. Mark the candidate on Log Sheet.
11	Continuing to answer after the final bell.	Test Room Regulation #9	Require immediate discontinuation. If the candidate persists, forcefully retrieve his/her Answer Sheet. Warn him/her that the candidacy may be revoked. Take note of the candidate's name on the Log Sheet for report to the Administration Board.
12	Absent.		Mark the candidate on the Log Sheet.
13	Candidate requests to leave the Test Room due to illness.		Communicate with the Test Administration Board to request assistance. Mark the candidate on Log Sheet. If the candidate requests to continue the test, he/she still must finish the test within the set time. The test session may not be extended. (Do not allow the candidate to exit ahead of the set time.)
