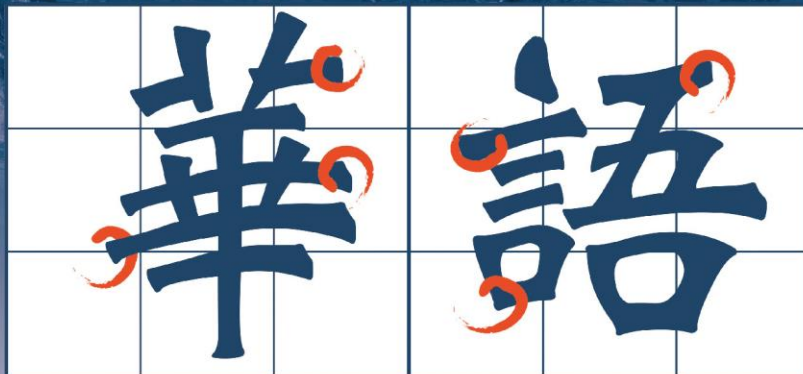


Program of Chinese Language and Culture for International Students

About

- The program was founded in 2007 and is now in Department of Chinese as a Second Language, National Taiwan Normal University. The program offers students a B. A. degree upon completion.
- Our program cultivates international human resources with advanced Chinese language and cross-cultural communication abilities, making them experts in Taiwanese and Chinese cultures.
- Our students come from more than 40 countries around the world, fostering a multicultural learning environment.

Goals & Features

- Our teachers help students achieve language proficiency by using lively teaching methods, featured with interactive classroom activities and cultural field trips.
- Our courses emphasize practical knowledge, such as teaching Chinese as a second language, museum cultural relics and tour guide practice, business Chinese, legal Chinese, etc.

Curriculum

- Minimum credits required for graduation: 128 credits
- Duration of study: 3 to 4 years, with the maximum of 6 years.
- Courses: Training in listening, speaking, reading, and writing; Chinese linguistics; daily Chinese culture and arts; Chinese teaching pedagogy; other courses in humanities, social science, and business.

Admissions

- The program admits students in fall only, with the yearly enrollment of 50.
- Application deadlines: March (For specific dates, see the Admission Prospectus issued by the Office of International Affairs.)
- Qualification: Applicants must have a high school diploma, do NOT have ROC (Taiwan) nationality, and do NOT speak Mandarin as their mother tongue.
- Time of Enrollment: September
